

## The Minnetonka Yacht Club 2022 Charter Boat Application

The Minnetonka Yacht Club (MYC) has established the Charter Boat Program to provide sail racing opportunities for motivated individuals and teams who do not own their own boats. The Charter program consists of MYC owned, well maintained sailboats that will be leased to individuals and teams that make the commitment to the boat and the sport.

This program is targeted towards sailors with a desire to race. You could be a recent college graduate with lots of desire to get into a competitive one-design, you might be a high-school or college sailor looking to augment your dinghy skills in a larger boat, or you might be an adult wanting to get back into racing. The end goal is to create new boat owners and grow MYC fleets.

In 2022 the MYC charter fleet consists of one 16' Youth X Boat, two Melges 15's, one 28' E scow, one 16' MC Scow, and one Yngling.

All MYC Charter boats have trailer, lift, sails and will be kept on Bug Island during the summer sailing season. MYC covers the cost of the boat, the lift, rental space on Bug Island (\$668 value), and insurance.

The Charter recipient is required to be a MYC member for the summer of 2022, pay 50% off the class racing fees, and provide a \$250 damage deposit. Although the charter boats are in good condition, repairs may be needed. Charter recipients are expected to repair boats and equipment as needed to maintain well working order. Boats should be returned in better condition than they were received in.

Applications will be accepted by the MYC Executive Director with an application deadline of February 15, 2022. All applications should be emailed to director@minnetonkayachtclub.org

The Charter Committee will meet with applicants prior to making a decision. Charters recipients will be announced by March 1, 2022.

- 1. Age of Team (15)
- 2. Plan for use of boat "regatta schedule" (20)
- 3. Strength of Sailing Resume (20)
- 4. Ability to Travel (10)
- 5. Commitment to MYC races (20)
