



## NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

# 2022 Championship of Champions – Minnetonka Yacht Club Wednesday, August 31, 2022

### 1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to Champions of active registered fleets of the Minnetonka and Wayzata Yacht Clubs.

2.2 Only the current registered skipper or registered co-skipper who is fleet champion (or current leader in the season championship series) is eligible to enter.

2.3 If the fleet champion is unavailable, the class Fleet Captain may select the next eligible skipper in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the standings, and accordingly down the standings until an eligible registered skipper can be selected.

2.4 Boats shall be sailed with a team of three (3) sailors. The eligible skipper shall select any one (1) crew of her or his choice. The third crew member shall be the owner or owner representative of the assigned Yngling.

2.5 The Organizing Authority “OA” may invite additional teams to represent the Race Committees, Club Commodores or others.

### 3. BOATS

3.1 The regatta will be sailed in 21’ Yngling keelboats, supplied by the Minnetonka Yacht Club Yngling fleet.

3.2 Sailors may not make adjustments to standing rigging or other equipment.

### 4. KEY DEADLINES & TIMING

Sunday August 28, 2022:

All entries shall be confirmed with MYC Vice Commodore David Sime by Email: [d.sime@att.net](mailto:d.sime@att.net) no later than 8-28-2022

Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Boat assignments will be selected by random draw for sail numbers by the OA. The assignments will be shared with the fleet representatives, to connect entered sailors with boat owners ahead of time. The MYC Yngling representative shall not be assigned to race her or his own boat.

Please Note: There may not be enough boats available for all interested fleets of the two clubs.

## **5. RACE SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Event Date: Wednesday, August 31, 2022
- 5.2 Warning signal for Race 1: 1800.
- 5.3 Two (2) Races are scheduled.
- 5.4 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

## **6. COURSES and MARKS**

Courses and Marks will be designated by radio (VHF 72) and/or verbal hail from the Race Committee "RC." All marks shall left to port, except if a Leeward Gate is set, or unless otherwise instructed by the RC.

## **7. THE START**

- 7.1 Appendix U (Audible Signal Racing System) shall apply.
- 7.2 The starting line shall be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a Race Committee boat and the course side of the nearest mark

## **8. CHANGE OF COURSE**

The Race Committee may change the location of the next mark of the course (or the finish line) without notification, except that any change shall be made before the first boat has rounded the previous mark.

## **9. THE FINISH**

The finish line shall be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a Race Committee boat and the course side of the nearest mark.

## **10. PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed. The One-Turn penalty in RRS 44.2 shall apply.

## **11. TIME LIMITS**

Each race time limit under RRS 35 shall be 40 minutes

## **12. SCORING**

The Low Point System in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.1
